K-1st Grade Lessons:

- Teachers are instructed to inform students to have their own art supplies, including magazines to cut pictures from prior to the lesson.
- Individual student activity, no shared Marine CSI materials.

- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- **♦** Large group activity with no social distancing.

- ♦ Teachers are instructed to inform students to have their own art supplies for drawing and coloring prior to the lesson.
- Individual student activity, no shared Marine CSI materials.

Sea Jellies Among Us

- ♦ Teachers are instructed to inform students to have their own glue sticks for art component prior to the lesson.
- Individual student activity, no shared Marine CSI materials

Baleen In-Between

- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Teachers are advised students will have multiple hands in water as part of activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials.

From the Poles to the Coast

- ♦ Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials.

Elasmo-Craze

- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Individual student activity, no shared Marine CSI materials.

2nd-3rd Grade Lessons:

Match My Habitat

- ♦ Teachers are instructed to inform students to have their own art supplies for drawing and coloring prior to the lesson.
- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Paired student activity with shared materials.

**Turtles, Turtles, Everywhere

- ♦ Teachers are instructed to inform students to have their own art supplies for drawing and coloring prior to the lesson.
- ♦ Some Marine CSI materials **not** able to be cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials.

One Shell or Two

- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials.

**"Web of Life"

- Marine CSI materials are divided per class.
- **♦** Large class activity with no social distancing and some shared materials.

Sealed With Blubber

- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Teachers are advised students will have multiple hands in water as part of activity.
- **♦** Small group activity with shared materials.

Made From Land, Made From Sea

- ♦ Teachers are instructed to inform students to have their own art supplies for drawing and coloring prior to the lesson.
- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Individual student activity, no shared Marine CSI materials.

Dichotomous Dilemma

- Teachers are instructed to inform students to have their own art supplies for drawing and coloring prior to the lesson.
- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Individual student activity, no shared Marine CSI materials.

4th-5th Grade Lessons:

- Marine CSI materials cannot be cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Large group activity with no social distancing and shared materials.

- **♦** Small group activity with shared materials.

Share and Share Alike

- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Teachers are advised students will have multiple hands in water as part of activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials.

**Invading Your Space

- ♦ No Marine CSI materials used for this activity.
- **♦** Large group activity with no social distancing.

Alternate Route

- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- ♦ Small group activity with shared materials.

Sea Level is On the Rise

- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Teachers are advised students will have multiple hands in water as part of activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials.

**Animal S.O.S.

- Marine CSI materials cannot be cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Large group activity with no social distancing and shared materials.

6th-8th Grade Lessons:

**"Sum of the Parts"

- ◆ Teachers are instructed to inform students to have their own art supplies for drawing and coloring prior to the lesson.
- Marine CSI materials are divided per class and discarded after each class has conducted the activity.
- Individual group activity with a whole class component with no social distancing.

Microscope Mania

- ♦ Teachers are instructed to inform students to have their own art supplies for drawing and coloring prior to the lesson.
- ♦ Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- **♦** Small group activity with shared materials.

Anatomy of a Beach

- Some Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected and some materials discarded after each class has conducted the activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials.

Terrapin Bingo

- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials.

Mighty Migrations

- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Large group activity with smaller groups and shared materials.

Calcium Carbonate Calamity

- Marine CSI materials are divided per student and per group. Materials per student discarded after use and materials per group cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials.

Marine CSI

- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials.

High School Lessons:

Going Up?

- Some Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected and some materials discarded after each class has conducted the activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials.

Are You Fit to Survive?

- ◆ Teachers are instructed to inform students to have their own art supplies for drawing prior to the lesson.
- Some Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class and some materials divided per class.
- Shared group activity with shared materials.

A Diplomatic Island

- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Shared group activity with shared materials.

**A Little Crab on a Big Decline

- Marine CSI materials discarded after each class has conducted the activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials with a **whole class component with no social distancing**.

**Sea Turtle Salvation

- ♦ Some Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected and some materials **cannot** be cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials.

**It's Getting Hot in Here

- Some Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected and some materials cannot be cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- Small group activity with shared materials.

**Tragedy of the Commons

- Marine CSI materials cleaned/disinfected after each class has conducted the activity.
- **♦** Large group activity with no social distancing.
